MOST COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT MOTOCROSS NORTHWEST AND THEIR INVOLVEMENT WITH MOTOCROSS

Question: Who and what is Motocross Northwest (MXNW) and what is its function in our sport of motocross?

Answer: MXNW was formed in 1986 by several local track promoters as a way to organize, schedule, promote and conduct motorcycle racing and be able to give back to the local riders. MXNW is the sanctioning racing body (much like the AMA). We support

the riders and overall integrity of our sport specific to the rider. The staff of MXNW are (or were) motocross racers, or family members of racers - accounting for many years of motocross experience. We enforce the rules and policies at the race track to help maintain an overall fair environment for the rider.

Question: What is the benefit of MXNW and why are they used at races?

Answer: MXNW's sole focus is in providing fair and equitable policies for the sport of motocross racing. Our efforts are specific to the rider, sportsmanship and integrity of our sport. MXNW maintains class structure with the changing bike sizes and skill levels, coupled with age group policies where applicable. We keep rider points for each rider and class, and manage class / rider skill advancement.

Question: Where does my membership money go?

Answer: The fee for the MXNW membership goes to creating data cards, maintaining membership information, making membership cards, computers and programs to maintain class structure and points accounting. The majority of the funds are used for rider appreciation days and year end giveaways.

Question: How does MXNW help the sport?

Answer: MXNW helps the sport by providing a safe environment for the racers and the spectators. It is our goal to create a family oriented environment that will attract new riders and keep current riders coming back for more fun and racing.
